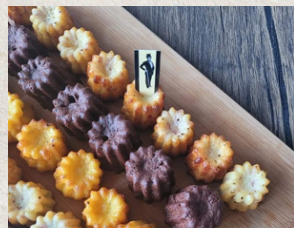

1. What are some of the key elements that define French interior design, and how do you incorporate those elements into your work?

French interior design combines European elegance with rustic comfort using neutral colors, natural materials such as timber and tiles, and layerings through wall panelling and feature flooring. These rustic elements create a welcoming and cozy atmosphere in European-style interiors.

2. What inspired you to pursue a career in interior design and how do you continue to cultivate and grow your passion for interior design, even after many years in the industry

I began with designing my first apartment and enjoyed the process of creation. Seeing concepts come to life and people using and experiencing the designs is powerful and motivating. My clients love all my projects, which is encouraging for my career.



3. How do you balance your professional aspirations with your responsibilities as a mother?

Balancing work and motherhood can be challenging due to limited time and a heavy workload. Planning and prioritizing family time is important, as staying connected with my children is a priority. I strive to give them attention even when work is busy.

My most meaningful project is my current home, designed after becoming a mother. It's a memorial design for my family, and practicality is a key feature to enhance our living experience. A merge of aesthetics and functionality was my approach to this project.
